The KLHA Board meeting was called to order by President Bob Maas at 9:30 at the Ideal Town Hall.

Discussion was held on KLHA volunteers to meet with the WOPOA board to continue our contact with their efforts on lake quality and continued information on invasive species issues.

Additional access volunteer appeal will be provided at the general meeting to assist in the access monitoring project.

The speaker at the general meeting on May 25 will be Bonnie Hiniker from Sunshine Gardens to provide information on shoreline restoration and improvement projects for lake property owners.

Jim Brandt from WOPOA will be asked to be available for information to members regarding shoreline restoration grants.
