KLHA Board Highlights 6/11/2016 – 5/7/2017

The KLHA Board has focused on the following issues:

- Coordinate the relationship of the KLHA and KLID boards to avoid overlap.
- Streamline the financial record keeping for efficiency and clarity.
- Participate in plans to determine the extent of the zebra mussel infestation, purchase equipment to search for ZMs early in the spring and to work with the KLID board in plans for control
- Continue to understand access monitoring issues related to Eurasian milfoil in the lake and means to keep it under control

It is our hope that continued diligence related to AIS including Eurasian milfoil and zebra mussels will result in the control of these infestations. Each homeowner must become educated about the threat of invasive species, contribute as able to provide the necessary means required to control the infestation and support the KLHA and KLID boards. Our lake community is unique in member participation and concern in working together for the future health of our lake. Members are actively involved in many ways: water quality, fish stocking, social gatherings, special events, setting loon nests, monitoring the access, AIS committee and KLID board.
