Labor Day 2015

Dear Kimble Lake property owner,

I cannot believe that it is almost Labor Day and that for many of us summer is drawing to a close. It seems like I just put my boatlift in.

This summer has been another successful summer for the Kimble Lake Improvement District. I am pleased to report that Eurasian Water Milfoil continues to be under control. Three full lake surveys have been completed and thus far only one infestation of EWM has been found. The infestation was promptly treated and hopefully it is now eradicated.

We partnered with Crow Wing County Land Services to test Kimble Lake water for the presence of infant Zebra mussels (veligers). Veligers in Kimble Lake would indicate that a reproducing adult population were alive and well. I am very pleased to report that we found no evidence of Zebra mussels in Kimble Lake.

Even though we are not aware of a Zebra mussel population in Kimble Lake we ask that you or your service provider inspect your lake equipment for any signs of Zebra mussels. Please call or email us if you have questions or suspect anything and/or would like a second set of eyes.

Please make sure all who provide lake services to your home have been trained and certified by the MN DNR. If you are not sure as to whether or not your service provider has been certified ask them or email me the name of the provider and I will check it for you. Please do all you can to help keep Kimble Lake clean and pristine.

We really appreciate your help on this. We also appreciate the help you have given us all year long by supporting Kimble Lake Homeowners Association and KLID. Double and triple thanks if you were an access monitor volunteer or even donated money to help pay for access monitors.

Thanks for all you do in helping to maintain the water quality in Kimble Lake. Have a great Labor Day weekend.
