A Little History on Keller Road

Did you know there was once a resort on Keller Road? Sue Mathewson shares what she's heard about its history, and what stands in its place today.

The resort was owned by Betty's grandfather. Our (the Mathewsons') place was cabin #1. We also owned cabin #2, which burned down in 1992. The Webers owned cabin #3, which they tore down to rebuild around 2000. The Cassidys bought the cabin; it was hit by lightning and burned. There were open lots, now owned and built on by the Hengstlers, Moses and Larsens. The "honeymoon cabins" came next, completing what was the resort.
