The Board will offer reports of last year's expenses especially concerning milfoil treatment and propose a levy to property tax forms to carry out its budget for the coming year. Elections and a time for discussion will also take place. Make plans now to attend both meetings, where brevity and thoroughness will be the order of the day.

Loon Nests Again in Place

Once again, two loon nesting platforms have been placed on our lake by the KLHA. The most occupied location is again on the south shore of the western most bay of the lake.

At least one pair of loons has been observed on the lake. At any rate, by the time you read this report one or both nests could have eggs for an early June hatch. Please respect and stay a good distance from the nests, especially prior to hatching. We have had a very successful loon breeding program over the past several years. Let's all make 2011 another loon-family-on-the-lake year!

Your Permit To Treat Needed

Thanks to all of you who have completed and returned the Authorization to Treat Forms that were sent to you. As of the first of April we had received completed forms from 79 Kimble Lake property owners. For those of you who have not returned the forms, please do so right away. We have to have your permission granted by these forms to treat Eurasian Milfoil, if it is found in front of your property. The DNR requires these forms to be updated every three years

We are one of a few lakes in Minnesota that has successfully controlled Eurasian Milfoil. Our success is the result of the cooperation and support of everyone living on Kimble Lake and the rapid response in identifying and treating the milfoil after it was discovered. Our expenses and use of chemicals were considerably reduced from prior years because none was discovered until October

Our continued success in the control of Eurasian Milfoil requires the support of all property owners. In the event that we have a milfoil infestation somewhere on Kimble where we do not have the permission to treat, that infestation will have the ability to grow making our control efforts that much more difficult and expensive. A timely response to any new infestation of Eurasian Milfoil is our best defense in controlling the milfoil and minimizing our use of treatment chemicals.

Please let us know, if you have misplaced or lost your Authorization to Treat Forms. We will be happy to send you a new form.
