Bass Lake Rocks Gone

Some of you know that one of our Kimble Lake residents witnessed folks from Bass Lake placing large rocks in the creek that connects our two lakes effectively blocking the channel and limiting the flow of water. Rather than attempt to remove the rocks, we reported the incident to the Minnesota DNR and they asked us to report the incident to the DNR Conservation Officer and the Crow Wing County Highway Engineers. This has been done. The placement of the rocks in the channel was a violation of a public waters statute and the Conservation Officers will take appropriate action. The Highway department removed the rocks and will continue to do so if the situation reoccurs.

Loon's Tale Lost

The following report comes to us from Denny Loechler and Gary Schwartz.

Loons did inhabite the nest on the south shore and eggs were lain. A baby loon was noted in the water mid-afternoon on June 25. But by 7:45 that evening it had disappeared. A second baby was born about 8:15 that night and had been seen with its parents around the lake. Now it is reported that a boat did run into the new family and the baby has not been seen since.

There also appears to be another pair of loons taking up residence on Kimble this year. For now it appears that we will be without the excitement of watching chicks grow up. Mother Nature and boater inattention have been our enemies. The former can't be helped, we've got work to do to stop the latter.
