### Rules

1. Abide by all Minnesota Fishing Regulations, which can be found at: [www.dnr.state.mn.us/regulations/fishing/index.html](http://www.dnr.state.mn.us/regulations/fishing/index.html)
2. All fish must be caught in Kimble Lake OR Lake Ossawinnamakee between sunrise and sunset on July 3rd

3. All submissions are on the Honor System

- Measure length from nose to tip of pinched tail to nearest ¼ inch
- There will be no central weigh-in so please practice Catch and Release
- Send just the species name and measured length to Kimble.Kontest@gmail.com (email) or text Jim Rusch at link.
- **Submission must be sent by 10:00pm on July 3rd**
- Photos are optional for your own scrapbook or storytelling...photos you submit may also be used in the KLHA Newsletter

Winners will be determined based on length information submitted
